Nurturing the Culture of Giving to African Public Institutions — Especially Schools

Africans, by nature, are not unkind when it comes to giving. However, because of our relatively low incomes and the weight of extended family responsibilities, our generosity has traditionally been directed inward—toward family members and close kin. The concept of giving to schools and other public institutions—an idea deeply rooted in the American culture of philanthropy—remains largely unfamiliar in Africa.

This must change. And indeed, Opoku Ware School is already showing the way. In less than a decade, our fraternity has built an endowment of **\$800,000—a truly historic feat. Even more remarkable is the fact that this sum was raised by fewer than 100 Akatakyie. More recently, Akatakyie USA completed two multipurpose facilities at a cost of \$70,000—executed at breakneck speed in under six months.**

Yet, behind these successes lies a challenge: the burden of giving has fallen on a very small fraction of Akatakyie in the U.S.—barely 10%. The question before us is simple but urgent: **How do we expand the base and inspire more Akatakyie to give?**

This is the essence of this year's Reunion theme: **nurturing the culture of giving.** Together, we will raise awareness that small contributions, when multiplied across many hands, can create mighty change. As the proverb reminds us: **little drops of water make the mighty ocean.**

The truth is clear: the only way to strengthen Africa's educational institutions, and indeed to make Africa rise again, is for us to **give back to our alma mater in every little way we can.** To borrow from the wisdom of John F. A Message from the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer

President John F. Kennedy, in inspiring the United States to embark on the difficult and risky mission onto the moon, said on September 12, 1962, "We choose to go to the moon in this decade and do the other things not because it is easy but because it is hard". In this spirit, AKATAKYIE USA, led by her Executives and Trustees, embarked on a journey to endow a MINIMUM \$1 M Fund for Opoku Ware School (OWASS) in 2016 and 2017. **The purpose of this Fund is to sustain OWASS as a center of excellence in secondary education in Ghana, and to provide opportunities for future OWASS students to participate in the digital and emerging technologies for human capacity development and wellbeing.** When the Fund is fully endowed, it could return an annual income of \$50,000 at 5.00% interest rate per annum in perpetuity for investments in select OWASS projects. Facing this challenge, AKATAKYIE from the United States and around the globe came together in unity with conviction, determination, and purpose for achieving this Great Milestone. Today, the market value of this Fund, in excess of \$800,000, is a true testament to the commitment of AKATAKYIE towards this cause. I would like to express sincere gratitude and thanks to the Board of Directors who have shown leadership, commitment and support by donating 86% of the total contribution of about \$614,860. I would also like to thank the Executives and the Trustees of AKATAKYIE USA for their unwavering support for the OWASS E-Fund. Sincere thanks to all who have contributed and pledged to contribute into the Fund. Special thanks also go to our Affiliate Members who have contributed about \$50,000 (~8.3%) into the Fund. We have made significant progress towards the MINIMUM \$1 M Target, but we are not there yet. Our goal is to reach this target by the 2026 Reunion. A number of strategies including new contributions, pledge redemptions, and corporate and philanthropic fundraising efforts are being deployed to achieve this goal. However, the greatest asset for achieving this goal is YOU. Please continue to sow into the OWASS E-Fund and leave a legacy with impact on future generations of Owareans and AKATAKYIE. Opoku Ware School da mo nyinaa ase anyaado!! Then shall our souls sing "All Hail Opoku Ware School, our Alma Mater!!" Thank you and may God richly bless the AKATAKYIE Brotherhood!!

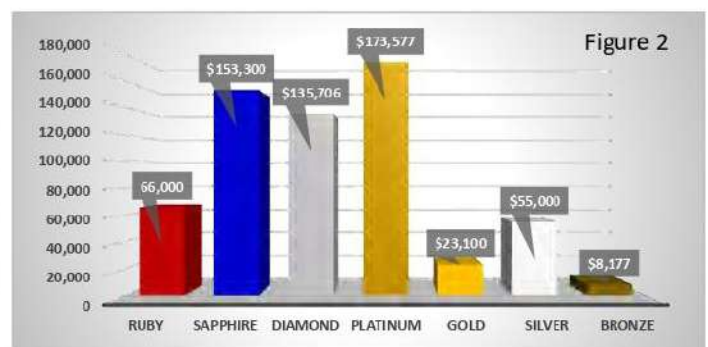
The OWASS E-FUND Investment Portfolio

The Opoku Ware School Endowment Fund (OWASS E-Fund) is a unique proposition, a daring adventure, and a creative solution for advancing secondary education in Ghana. The OWASS E-Fund is a pioneering effort by AKATAKYIE USA to fund strategic initiatives to advance total quality education at Opoku Ware School. **The purpose of this Fund is to sustain OWASS as a center of excellence in secondary education in Ghana, and to provide opportunities for future OWASS students to participate in the digital and emerging technologies for human capacity development and wellbeing.** To this end AKATAKYIE USA and the Global AKATAKYIE Brotherhood have devoted their energies, resources, and capacities, with commitment, dedication, and a laser-focused attention to duty to see the realization of this DREAM of OWASS E-Fund and the achievement of this GREAT MILESTONE of a MINIMUM \$1 M Target.



Figures 1 and 2 show the updated OWASS E-Fund. Figure 1 shows the global E-Fund contribution profile, market value, and expenses. Figure 2 shows the contribution categories, and their respective amounts. The contribution categories include RUBY (20,000 – 29,999), SAPPHIRE (\$15,000 – \$19,999); DIAMOND (\$10,000 – \$14,999); PLATINUM (\$5,000 – \$9,999), GOLD (\$3,000 – \$4,999), SILVER (\$1,000 – \$2,999) and BRONZE (<\$1,000).

The updated E-Fund contributions are equivalent to \$614,860, with total expenses in the amount of \$13,250¹. The market value of the OWASS E-Fund is \$807,694² (as at 5:00 PM EST on Tuesday, August 12, 2025). This comprises Merrill Lynch investment portfolio of \$704,883 (including an Unrealized Gain of \$150,589), Fidelity investment portfolio of \$76,334, and Bank of America savings/checking accounts with a balance of \$25,884.

Let me emphasize that the attainment of this GOAL does not end contributions into the OWASS E-Fund. The significance of achieving this Target is that we will begin to invest income from the E-Fund in select OWASS projects that align with the purpose of the E-Fund. The GOAL is to complete the MINIMUM \$1 MILLION Target at the 2026 Reunion of AKATAKYIE USA in Manassas, VA where it all began. In 2017, the Founding Board of Directors and the Governing Articles for the OWASS E-Fund were officially inaugurated creating the momentum towards the future of this defining moment. Notwithstanding the treacherous terrains we have travelled, the headwinds and resistances we have endured, we will complete the mission, and say with Neil Armstrong, "If there is one word I would remove from kids' vocabulary, it would be the word "CAN'T". For all things are possible for them that believe as Scripture says!!

A number of strategies will be adopted towards this GOAL. These strategies include (i) redeeming the outstanding pledges currently in the amount of \$269,245; (ii) generating new contributions; (iii) increasing Sapphire Contributors to 20, Diamond to 35, Platinum to 60, and Silver to 100; (iv) increasing the number of donors; and (v) reaching out to corporations and philanthropists for additional donations. Let us all contribute as individual donors or as part of our Year Groups and/or redeem our pledges to build a strong legacy with impact on future generations of Owareans and AKATAKYIE!!

On behalf of the OWASS E-Fund Board of Directors, I would like to thank the leadership of AKATAKYIE USA for the VISION of creating the OWASS E-Fund. I would also like to thank the Founding Board Executive Officers under the leadership of Okatakylie Dr. Richard Okine (C3) for steering the E-Fund in the right direction and the current Board Officers for continuing the great work of building to Great Legacy with Impact. Finally, a great shout of thanks to the Board of Directors for contributing 86% of the E-Fund and to all categories of donors and pledged donors for their eternal sacrifices for generations unborn.

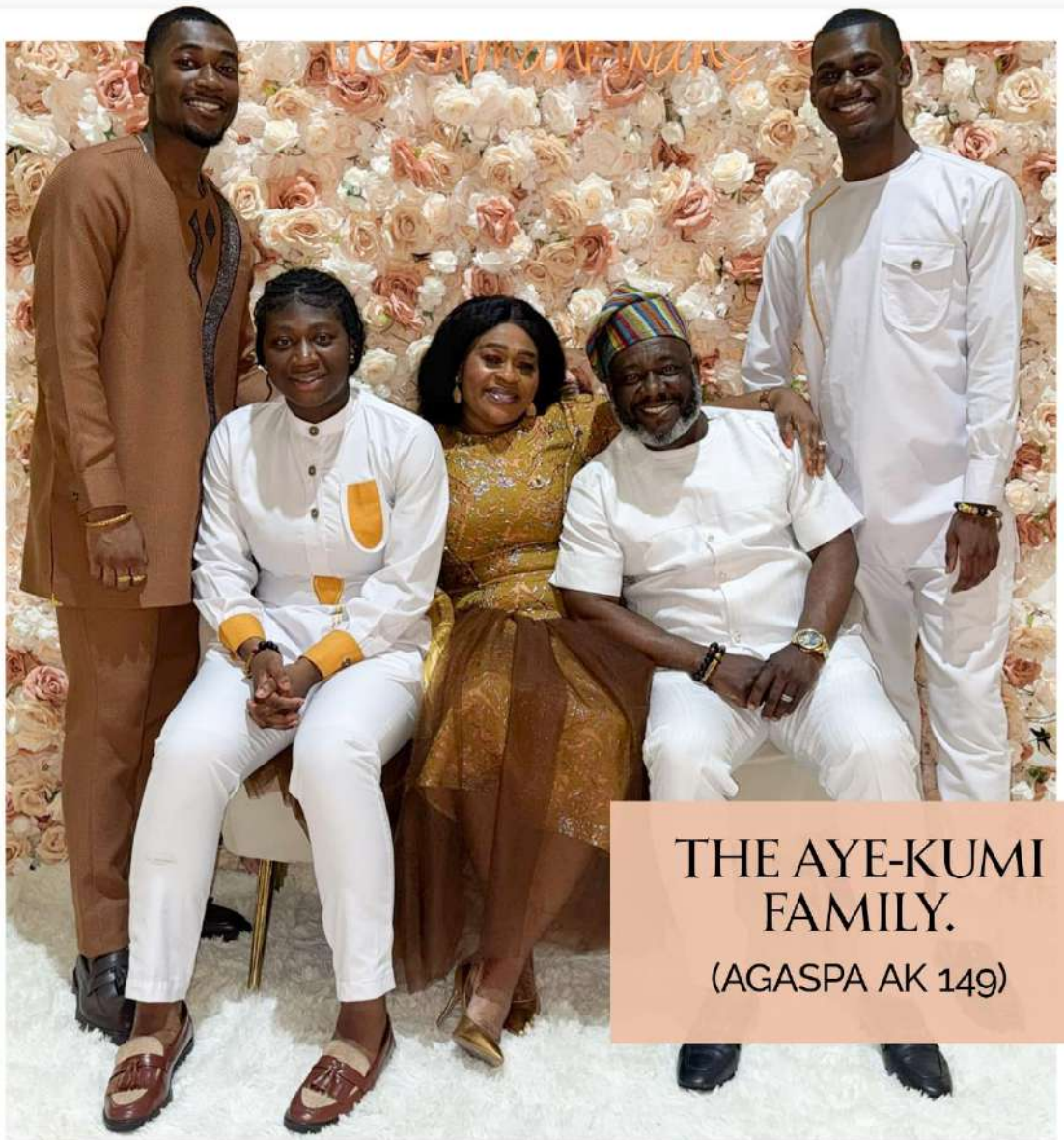

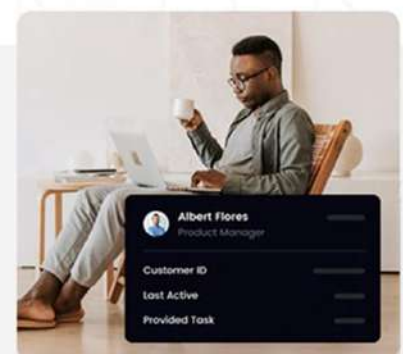
